The purpose of the Private Security Disciplinary Review Committee (DRC) is to review applicants' appeals of the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services' (Bureau) denials of licensure and licensees' appeals of the Bureau's suspensions and imposition of fines. The Private Security DRC is authorized to hear appeals of private proprietary security employers and officers, as registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.4 (commencing with Section 7574 of the Business and Professions Code), and private patrol operators, private patrol operator qualified managers, security guards, firearm permit holders, firearm training facilities and instructors, and baton training facilities and instructors, licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.5 (commencing with Section 7580 of the Business and Professions Code).

Collin Wong Susan Johnson Leslye Tinson Lawrence Garcia Matthew Lujan Cases are heard in order of arrival, so Respondents should confirm their appearance and arrival time by signing in on the "Respondent Sign-In" sheet upon entering the designated waiting room. However, the DRC may hear a case out of order due to hardship-related circumstances. The DRC will consider requests to be heard out of order on a case-by-case basis.

Persons that are not listed as a Respondent on the meeting's Agenda are not required to add their name to the sign-in list. This is an open meeting and any person may attend as a member of the public. Public attendees should not sign-in on the "Respondent Sign-In" sheet.

Important: No unscheduled cases will be heard by the DRC; Respondents with appeals pending should not sign-in if they are not listed on the agenda. Respondents with appeals pending may attend the public portions of the meeting as a member of the public and submit comment during public comment periods, however, Respondents may not address the DRC with regard to their own appeal.
